

Snowy River Extreme Race 6th October 2019



This year four Adelaide Canoe Club members joined about 170 enthusiastic white water paddlers at Island Bend campground on the Snowy River, below Guthega Dam to test their skills.

Warm weather and rain in the week before the race caused lots of snow melt which resulted in a much high grade of rapids on the river this year. These testing conditions required the organisers to change the location on the race slightly from previous years.

Safety was well organised along the river and although there were some bruises there were no major injuries during the race.



The race is divided into 'Expert' and 'Intermediate' sections with kayaks, canoes and inflatable rafts all welcome to compete.





Simon Langsford and Leigh Richardson teamed up again this year and achieved 9th place in the Intermediate section. Steve Wild and Anne Langsford were scratchings due to injury and the unexpectedly high water flows respectively.
